

Article Overview

To set up a router for a 100M fiber optic connection, connect the fiber to an ONT, link the ONT to a compatible router via Ethernet, and configure the router with your ISP credentials and Wi-Fi settings.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals for your router, usually provided by your ISP .
- o Fiber-ready router: Ensure it supports at least 100 Mbps; gigabit routers are recommended for future-proofing .

- o Set up Wi-Fi: choose a network name (SSID), strong password, and select WPA3 or WPA2 security .
- o Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you prioritize video calls, gaming, or streaming .

Step 5: Optimize Your Network

- o Place the router in a central, open location for optimal Wi-Fi coverage .
- o Use wired connections for devices requiring stable, low-latency performance .
- o Regularly test your internet speed to ensure you are achieving close to 100 Mbps .
- o Keep fiber connectors clean and avoid sharp bends to prevent signal loss .
