- o Custom Angles: Some systems offer 45° or other angled vertical bends for smoother transitions, reducing stress on cables and improving installation flexibility .

They are compatible with various tray types, including ladder, perforated, and wire mesh trays . The bends are often supplied with appropriate fastening hardware for secure attachment to the main tray run .

- o Bend Radius: Maintaining the correct bend radius is critical to prevent cable damage, especially for fiber optic or sensitive power cables .
- o Height Compatibility: Bends are manufactured to match the side height of the cable tray, commonly 50 mm or 60 mm, ensuring proper fit and structural stability .
- o Load and Safety: Ensure the bend can support the weight of the cables and complies with relevant electrical and mechanical standards.
