To improve fire resistance, additional measures are often applied:

- o Fireproof coatings or intumescent paints: These can insulate the tray and delay heat transfer to cables .
- o Fire partitions and barriers: Physical separation of cable runs can prevent fire spread.
- o Automatic fire suppression systems: Sprinklers or gas-based systems provide active protection.
- o Compliance with standards: Ensuring that cable trays and wiring meet local fire safety codes, such as CE marking, ECAS certification, or ATEX directives in hazardous areas .

## Practical Considerations

- o Hot-dip galvanized trays are suitable for industrial, commercial, and infrastructure projects, especially where corrosion and moderate fire resistance are required .
- o For high-stakes or extreme environments, such as desert climates or explosive atmospheres, additional fireproofing layers (e.g., aluminized polypropylene scrim) are recommended .
- o Regular inspection and maintenance are essential to prevent overheating, corrosion, or insulation damage that could compromise fire safety .

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## Conclusion

While hot-dip galvanized cable trays provide enhanced durability and moderate fire resistance, they are not fully fireproof. For critical applications, they should be combined with fireproof coatings, fire barriers, and compliant installation practices to ensure the safety of electrical systems and personnel.
