- o **Divider Panels and Roof Covers:** Modular solutions like Nexpond roof divider panels allow customizable cable routing. End covers and top covers complete the tray system, maintaining a clean and secure cable path .
- o **Channel-Type Cable Managers:** These trays feature perforated channels for individual cable separation, clear markings for easy identification, and can support the weight of network switches or patch panels .

Installation Considerations

- o Ensure the tray is aligned with the cabinet row using baying brackets if multiple cabinets are connected .
- o Maintain separation of power and data cables to reduce interference.
- o Use end and top covers to prevent cables from spilling over and to protect them from dust or accidental contact.
- o Verify that the tray can support the weight of the cables and any attached devices, especially in high-density setups .

Accessories and Maintenance

- o Grounding studs or straps for electrical safety.
- o Cable ties or Velcro straps to secure cables within channels.
- o Blanking panels or covers to maintain airflow and aesthetics .
