Inspection and Assessment

Minor bends may be corrected, but severely deformed or cracked corners should be replaced to ensure the tray can safely support cables and prevent strain or damage to the wiring .

Using Connectors and Supports

Cable tray corners are often joined using angle connectors or adjustable corner fittings. These connectors allow smooth routing of cables around corners without sharp bends, which can damage cables . When repairing a corner:

- o Remove the damaged section if necessary.
- o Install a new angle connector or corner fitting, ensuring it aligns with the existing tray sections.
- o Secure the connector with bolts and combination nuts, passing screws from the inner side to avoid contact with cables .
- o For wider trays (over 400 mm), use a joint plate to prevent transverse bending under load .

Replacement vs. Repair

- o Minor damage: Small bends or loose fasteners can be corrected by tightening bolts, realigning the tray, or using clamp supports .
- o Severe damage: Broken welds, cracked rails, or heavily deformed corners require full section replacement to maintain the tray's load-bearing capacity and safety .
- o Ensure that replacement components are compatible with the existing tray type (ladder, solid, or trough) and material (galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum) to prevent corrosion and maintain structural integrity .

Cable Protection During Repair

While repairing corners, avoid damaging cables by:

- o Using smooth corner supports or guides to maintain proper bending radius .
- o Ensuring fasteners do not contact cables directly .

Preventive Measures

- o Conduct regular inspections for corrosion, loose fasteners, or deformation .
- o Use anti-loosening washers or locking nuts at critical joints to prevent future loosening .
