The standard cable tray nut size commonly used is M6, paired with M6 bolts for secure fastening.

Recommended Nut Size

For most cable tray installations, an M6 nut is standard, often used with a 16mm M6 bolt and a serrated flange nut to provide vibration resistance and a reliable hold . This combination is suitable for electrical, mechanical, and construction applications where quick, safe, and durable fastening is required.

Factors Affecting Nut Selection

- o Tray Type and Material: Aluminum or steel trays may require specific nut grades to match strength and corrosion resistance .
- o Load and Cable Volume: Heavier cable loads or larger trays may require larger bolts and nuts (e.g., M8 or M10) to ensure structural stability.
- o Vibration and Environmental Conditions: Serrated flange nuts are preferred in environments with vibration to prevent loosening .
- o Compatibility: Always ensure the nut matches the bolt thread size and type used in the tray system.

Practical Tips

- o Use fully threaded bolts with matching nuts for maximum grip.
- o For heavy-duty or industrial applications, consult the tray manufacturer's specifications to confirm the recommended nut size.
- o Ensure proper torque is applied to avoid over-tightening, which can damage the tray or strip threads. In summary, M6 nuts with M6 bolts are the most commonly used for standard cable tray installations, but adjustments may be needed based on tray size, load, and environmental conditions .
