Overview

A cable tray with a communication partition is designed to divide the tray into separate sections, allowing power cables and data/communication cables to run in the same tray without causing electromagnetic interference (EMI) or signal disruption . These partitions are particularly useful in industrial, commercial, and data center environments where multiple cable types coexist.

- o Separate Trays Preferred: Whenever possible, run power and data cables in separate trays to minimize EMI .
- o Support and Spacing: Ensure trays are properly supported and spaced to prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity .
- o Compliance: Use trays and dividers that meet relevant standards such as IEC 61537 for load-bearing and safety .
