Support and Bracket Types

Cable trays are supported by mechanical elements such as wall brackets, cantilever brackets, pendant suspensions, or ceiling-mounted supports. These support elements connect the tray to structural surfaces like walls, ceilings, or steel beams, providing stability and load-bearing capacity for the cables routed within the tray. For ceiling installations, TKS, KTA, or KTUG cantilever brackets are commonly used, sometimes combined with threaded rod suspensions for additional support.

Fastening Methods

Cable trays are typically fastened to brackets using mushroom head bolts or other verified fasteners. For example, RS 60 cable trays with rail heights of 60 mm and widths from 100 to 300 mm are attached to cantilever brackets with two mushroom head bolts (FLM 6X12 or FLM 6X16 F). Threaded rods can also be anchored directly to ceilings or walls, either vertically or at a 45° angle using bracket adapters, depending on the installation requirements.

Installation Considerations

- o Load Distribution: Brackets must support the weight of the cable tray and the cables, including any additional imposed loads such as wind, ice, or short-circuit forces.
- o Spacing: Horizontal and vertical changes in tray direction should be supported near joints, typically within 150 mm, to maintain structural integrity.
- o Compliance: Installations should follow relevant standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable trays and BS 6946 for channel support systems, ensuring safe and reliable operation.
- o Material Selection: Cable trays and brackets are available in steel, aluminum, or stainless steel, with finishes chosen based on environmental conditions to prevent corrosion and maintain durability.
