## Internal Fiber Networks

Within a home or office, fiber can be run internally to extend high-speed connections to specific rooms or devices. This is known as internal fiber networking or Fiber to the Desk/Room. Even in these cases, each endpoint typically requires a device to convert the optical signal for use by standard Ethernet devices.
