They provide IP66/IP68 or UL type 4X protection and strain relief according to EN 62444, ensuring both safety and hygiene .

Cables used in cleanrooms are halogen-free, chemical-resistant, and low particle-emission, suitable for power, data, and control applications. They comply with DIN EN ISO 14644-1 and VDI 2083 Part 8, ensuring suitability for controlled environments in pharmaceutical, semiconductor, and food industries . Specialized cables include flexible, torsion-capable, and industrial Ethernet cables for moving applications or robotic systems .
