

Connect the fiber optic box to the router via network cable

To connect your fiber optic box (ONT) to a router, use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port after properly installing and powering the ONT.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, this device converts the fiber optic light signal into an electrical signal your router can use .
- o Router: Ensure it has a WAN or Internet port compatible with Ethernet input .

- o Take the Ethernet cable and plug one end into the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port .
- o Plug the other end into your router's WAN/Internet port, which is often labeled and colored differently from LAN ports .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 4: Optimize Placement and Settings

- o Place both the ONT and router near electrical outlets and in a dry, ventilated area .
- o For best performance, use a high-quality Ethernet cable and ensure the router supports gigabit speeds to fully leverage fiber internet .
- o Access the router's configuration interface (usually via 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to verify settings and enable features like Quality of Service (QoS) if needed .

Step 5: Verify Connection

- o Check the ONT lights: Power should be solid green, and the data/Internet light should indicate active communication .
- o Test internet connectivity on a device connected to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. By following these



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steps, your fiber optic internet will be properly routed through the ONT to your router, ensuring high-speed, stable connectivity throughout your home .
