

Connecting jumpers to the PoE switch

Jumpers on a PoE switch or adapter are used to control power delivery, allowing you to enable or disable PoE output to connected devices while ensuring proper data transmission.

Understanding Jumpers in a PoE Setup

Jumpers are small connectors or pins that can be configured to enable or disable PoE output on certain ports. They are commonly found on PoE adapters or devices like the MikroTik GPeR, where connecting all jumpers allows power to flow in both directions, and removing them disables PoE passthrough if the connected device does not require power . This is particularly useful when mixing PoE and non-PoE devices on the same network.

Step-by-Step Connection Guide

- o Check Device Compatibility: Ensure your devices support the PoE standard provided by the switch (IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt) and verify the power requirements .
- o Connect Ethernet Cables:
 - o Plug each device's Ethernet cable into a PoE-enabled port on the switch.
 - o For devices that do not require PoE, either use a non-PoE port or disable PoE output using the jumpers .
- o Configure Jumpers:
 - o If your PoE adapter or device has jumpers, connect them according to the manufacturer's instructions to enable PoE output.
 - o Remove jumpers if you want to disable power passthrough to a non-PoE device .
- o Power the Switch: Connect the PoE switch to an AC power source. The switch will automatically detect PoE-enabled devices and supply power over the Ethernet cables .
- o Connect to Network: Use an uplink port to connect the PoE switch to your router or NVR. This ensures both data and power are transmitted correctly to all devices .

Best Practices

- o Use Quality Ethernet Cables: Only use copper twisted-pair cables rated for PoE to ensure safe and efficient power delivery .
- o Monitor Power Budget: Ensure the total power consumption of connected devices does not exceed the switch's power budget .
- o Label Ports: Clearly label PoE and non-PoE ports to avoid accidental overloading or misconfiguration .
- o Test Devices: After connecting, verify that each device powers on and communicates properly with the network. By following these steps, jumpers can be effectively used to manage PoE output, ensuring safe and



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reliable operation of your network devices.
