Each field has a specified number of characters and is defined as follows: Room (up to 5 capitalized characters) => the room in which the component is located; if component is in a corridor use "CORR". Equipment Name (up to 8 capitalized characters) => the name of the particular type of equipment. According to the U. Department of Energy, good breaker box labeling helps with three things in practice: less stress during emergencies. It also aligns with general electrical panel labeling requirements, which are part of NEC -based expectations for clarity and identification.
