

Default password for IBM fiber optic switches

Article Overview

The default login for IBM 3534 F08 Fibre Switches is typically admin for the username and password for the password.

IBM 3534 F08 Fibre Switch Default Credentials

For initial access to an IBM 3534 F08 Fibre Switch, the default credentials are:

- o Username: admin
- o Password: password These credentials allow you to log in to the switch management interface for the first time or after a factory reset .

Notes on Brocade SAN Switch Modules in IBM Systems

If your IBM switch uses a Brocade 4 Gb or 8 Gb SAN module, the default login may vary depending on the firmware version:

- o Before FOS v6.2.0e: USERID = USERID, Password = PASSWORD
- o From FOS v6.2.0e onward: Username = admin, Password = password This change was implemented to standardize default credentials across newer firmware releases .

Additional Tips

- o Always change the default password immediately after first login to maintain security.
- o Check the switch installation guide or user manual for firmware-specific default credentials.
- o If the switch has been previously configured, a factory reset may be required to restore default login credentials. Using these default credentials, you can access the IBM Fibre Switch interface and perform initial configuration or maintenance tasks safely.

All IBM switches I've used use admin/admin as the default. You can also try passw0rd as the password for some of those username



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Change the passwords for operating system IDs by using the passwd command. Only if your system uses the basic user registry,

When you log in as admin and the default password is not changed from the manufacturer default, you are prompted
