

Dimensions and weight of fiber optic splice box

Fiber optic splice boxes typically range from compact sizes around 115 x 61 x 113 mm to larger rack-mounted modules, with weight depending on material and capacity.

- o Rack-Mountable Modules: Designed for DIN rail or 19" mounting, these splice boxes have a compact, uniform design with ample interior space for fiber connections. Exact dimensions vary by manufacturer but are generally larger than compact boxes to accommodate more splices .
- o Fiber Optic Splice Modules (FOSM): These modules are designed to fit within Panduit rack-mounted enclosures and support 24 fusion splices or 12 mechanical splices per module. Dimensions are provided in inches and metric units in manufacturer datasheets .

Material and Weight Considerations

- o Materials: Splice boxes are commonly made from metal or glass-fiber reinforced polyester, providing durability and protection for fiber splices .
- o Weight: While specific weights are not always listed, compact boxes like the FIMP-M are lightweight due to their small size and plastic or composite construction. Metal rack-mounted boxes are heavier, typically ranging from 1-3 kg depending on size and number of splices. Weight increases with additional protective features or larger capacity.
