The ANSI/TIA/EIA-942-A (data center) standard recommends a cold aisle width of 1.2 meters (which is equivalent to two floor tiles) to allow a perforated tile to be placed in front of each cabinet which allows for cold air to be delivered to the cabinet front. A CAC system surrounds the cold aisle and it keeps cold supply air separate from hot server exhaust air. This method raises the temperature of the air returning to a Computer Room Air.
