Technical Standards and Regulations NEC (National Electrical Code) Article 300. 3 (C) (1):. Question 1: Can mechanical utility piping or tubing containing water or compressed air be installed in cable trays with electrical cables? Answer: No. NEC section 300-8 does not permit.
