- o Port Density: Plan for 25-30% more ports than currently needed to allow future expansion .
- o Termination Standards: Follow T568B wiring for horizontal cabling to ensure consistency .
- o Shielding: Use shielded (STP) panels in high EMI environments; unshielded (UTP) is sufficient for most offices .
- o Rack Layout: Place heavy equipment like UPS units at the bottom, and maintain logical cable flow for airflow and easy maintenance .
