

Article Overview

Emergency replacement of FC fiber optic cables requires a prepared restoration kit, pre-stripped replacement cables, and rapid splicing techniques to minimize downtime.

Key Steps for Emergency Replacement

- o **Locate and Access the Cable Break** Identify the damaged section and remove at least 10 meters (32 feet) of cable on either side of the cut. Use an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to verify that the remaining cable is undamaged before proceeding with repairs .
- o **Prepare the Replacement Cable** Ideally, the emergency cable should be pre-stripped, cleaned, and loaded into splice closures. FC-compatible cables, such as the Haile Single-mode 2-core Field Fiber Optic Cable, are designed for rapid deployment and include aviation joints and FC emergency repair mechanisms for quick on-site fixes .
- o **Splicing the Fibers**
 - o **Mechanical Splicing:** Use mechanical splices for immediate restoration when service cannot be interrupted. Pre-load fibers into splice trays to save time .
 - o **Fusion Splicing:** Can be performed later for a more permanent repair once service is stabilized.
- o **Testing and Verification** After splicing, check system alarms or test with an OTDR to ensure signal integrity before sealing the splice closures .

- o Pre-stripped and cleaned replacement cables compatible with FC connectors
- o Splice closures with sufficient capacity
- o Mechanical splices and splice trays
- o Fiber cleavers, strippers, and cleaning tools
