- o Strength Members: Materials like aramid yarn (Kevlar) or steel wire braiding add significant weight.
- o Outer Jacket and Protective Layers: UV-resistant, water-blocking, or armored jackets increase weight.
- o Environmental Considerations: Cables for aerial, underground, or underwater use may include extra protective layers, further increasing weight .
