They are particularly useful for MPO and single fiber connectors, ensuring that contamination or damage is detected before installation . 3. **Optical Power Meters and Light Sources** When an OTDR is unavailable, a combination of a light source and optical power meter can perform basic tests to measure fiber attenuation and verify signal transmission. This method is simpler but effective for quick on-site checks . 4. **Cleaning Tools** Proper cleaning is critical to prevent contamination that can degrade performance. Tools like the Opti-Clean reel cleaner and swabs for 1.25mm and 2.5mm ferrules ensure that SC, LC, FC, ST, and E2000 connectors are free of dust and debris before testing or deployment . 5. **Certification and Verification Testers** Advanced testers can certify fiber performance according to industry standards, measuring insertion loss, optical return loss, and other key parameters. These instruments are used both during installation and for ongoing maintenance to ensure network reliability .
