Coupler Function

The fiber optic coupler, also known as a flange or adapter, is installed inside the terminal box to connect two fiber optic cables. Common types include FC, ST, SC, and LC, which correspond to different connector standards . Couplers allow direct or branched connections, enabling signal distribution and network expansion without compromising signal quality.

- o Wall-Mount Boxes: Compact enclosures for indoor or outdoor use, suitable for small-scale deployments and network rooms .
- o Rack-Mount Boxes: Larger boxes with multiple ports (12, 24, 48) for structured cabling in data centers .
- o DIN Rail Boxes: Space-saving boxes mounted on DIN rails, often with 6-12 ports and customizable adapter types (LC, SC, ST, FC, E2000), ideal for mini-network distributions .
