 - o Swap suspect transceivers with known-good units.
 - o Reboot switches, routers, or media converters to resolve temporary glitches.
 - o Check indicator LEDs (e.g., LOS - Loss of Signal) for connectivity issues .
- o Configuration Checks
 - o Verify IP settings, routing, and firmware versions.
 - o Ensure proper connector types and polarities (UPC vs APC) to minimize reflectance and insertion loss .
- o Repair or Replacement
 - o Re-splice or replace damaged fiber sections using proper fusion splicing tools.
 - o Re-route cables to avoid tight bends and improve mechanical protection .

Preventive Measures

- o Regularly inspect and clean connectors.
- o Use protective caps when connectors are not in use.
- o Maintain proper cable routing and avoid exceeding bend radius.
- o Monitor network performance with tools like PRTG or Wireshark to detect early signs of degradation .
- o Adhere to industry standards for insertion loss and return loss budgets .
