How Fiber Optic Cables Work

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light through ultra-thin glass or plastic strands, enabling high-speed, low-latency, and reliable internet compared to traditional copper cables . The fiber line entering your home does not plug directly into a standard router because routers require electrical signals, not optical signals .

Role of the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

The ONT is a device provided by your internet service provider (ISP) that serves as the interface between the fiber network and your home network. It performs optoelectronic conversion, translating incoming light signals from the fiber into standard electrical signals that routers and computers can understand . The ONT typically has:

- o An optical port for the fiber cable connection
- o Ethernet ports to connect to your router or gateway
- o Power input and status indicators Some setups combine the ONT and router into a single device, especially in smaller homes .

Connecting Fiber to Your Router

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- o Connect the fiber cable to the ONT: Remove protective caps, align the connector, and insert until it clicks securely .
- o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes), .
- o Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port .
- o Power on the router and confirm connectivity via indicator lights.
- o Access the router's admin panel to enter ISP credentials if required and update firmware for optimal performance .

- o Use high-quality Ethernet cables (Cat6a or higher) to maintain maximum speeds .
- o Place the router strategically for optimal Wi-Fi coverage.
- o Regularly update firmware and secure your network with strong passwords .
