A fiber optic pigtail junction box is commonly called a splice closure or fiber termination box.

Fiber optic pigtail junction boxes are enclosures designed to house and protect the splicing of fiber optic pigtails to main fiber cables. These boxes provide a secure environment for fusion or mechanical splicing, ensuring low-loss, reliable connections while organizing multiple fibers in a compact space . The bare end of a pigtail is spliced inside these boxes, while the connectorized end plugs into patch panels, ODFs, or active equipment .

Common Types of Fiber Optic Junction Boxes

- o Splice Closures: Sealed enclosures used for outdoor or underground fiber splicing, protecting fibers from environmental factors like moisture, dust, and temperature changes .
- o Fiber Termination Boxes: Indoor enclosures that provide organized splice trays for pigtails, often mounted on walls or inside racks .
- o Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs): Larger frames that combine multiple splice trays and patch panels, allowing high-density fiber management and easy access for maintenance .

Key Features

- o Splice Trays: Hold and protect individual splices, preventing bending or stress on fibers.
- o Cable Entry Ports: Allow secure routing of incoming and outgoing fiber cables.
- o Connector Access: Provide ports for the connectorized ends of pigtails to interface with patch panels or equipment.
- o Environmental Protection: Many outdoor boxes are weatherproof and resistant to dust, water, and UV exposure. In practice, the term "splice closure" is most commonly used for outdoor or rugged applications, while "fiber termination box" is used for indoor or structured cabling environments. Both serve the same purpose: to provide a secure, organized, and low-loss junction point for fiber optic pigtails .
