What It Is

A fiber to Ethernet connector is usually part of a fiber media converter, a networking device that converts signals between fiber-optic and copper Ethernet cables. This allows devices with standard RJ-45 Ethernet ports to communicate over fiber networks, which can extend network distances far beyond the 100-meter limit of copper cables and provide higher bandwidth and faster speeds .
