

# Fire Protection Requirements for Cable Trays in Barbados

## Article Overview

Cable trays in Barbados must be installed with fire-resistant materials, proper sealing, and compliance with national standards to ensure safety and maintain functionality during a fire.

## Regulatory Context

In Barbados, electrical installations, including cable trays, are subject to Barbados National Standards (BNS) and oversight by the Building Standards Authority under the Ministry of Transport & Works . While specific fire codes for cable trays are not publicly detailed, compliance with international standards adopted locally (such as ISO or CARICOM standards) is generally required. Approval from the Planning and Development Department may be necessary for non-domestic or institutional buildings, including hotels, hospitals, and industrial facilities .

## Fire Protection Measures

### 1. Firestopping at Penetrations

- o Cable trays passing through floors or walls must have firestopping applied to prevent fire and smoke spread .
  - o Recommended measures include firestop packs, fire-resistant boards, mineral wool, or firestop mastic.
  - o Gaps between firestop materials and cables should not exceed 1 cm<sup>2</sup>, and packing thickness should be at least 24 cm.
  - o For large openings, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing, and cover plates should be square, consistent, and painted evenly .
- ### 2. Waterstops and Fire-Support Plates
- o At slab penetrations, a waterstop of at least 50 mm is recommended at floor level.
  - o A fire-support plate should be installed at the top of the penetration to enhance fire resistance .
- ### 3. Material Selection

- o Indoor cable trays: painted steel or galvanized steel.
  - o Outdoor or high-humidity environments: hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum alloy, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic .
  - o Fire protection coatings or tapes, such as FLAMMOTECT-A or DG-CR 0.7, can provide additional resistance to flame propagation and environmental factors .
- ### 4. Layout and Installation
- o Cable trays should follow the shortest and straightest path, avoiding unnecessary crossings or detours .
  - o Segregation of power and signal cables is recommended to reduce interference and maintain safety.
  - o Installation must allow for maintenance access and ensure that fire protection measures are not compromised during routine work .

## Maintenance and Compliance

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- o Regular inspection of firestopping, coatings, and tray integrity is essential to ensure ongoing compliance.
- o Any modifications to cable trays or penetrations should maintain the original fire-resistance rating.
- o Documentation of materials, installation methods, and fire ratings may be required for building approvals or safety audits in Barbados.

- o Properly firestopped at wall and floor penetrations
  - o Installed with fire-resistant materials suitable for the environment
  - o Routed according to technical and safety standards
