China continues to expand its 5G infrastructure, with plans to construct over 4.5 million additional 5G base stations in 2025, alongside trials for 10-gigabit optical networks and enhancements to computing power centers to support AI growth . This expansion positions China to lead in 6G research, with field test networks already demonstrating 6G-level transmission capabilities using existing 4G and 5G platforms .

China Tower's infrastructure is a critical pillar of the digital economy, enabling industries to leverage real-time data, AI analytics, and IoT platforms. For example, in Jiangsu Huai'an Industrial Park, 5G networks allow continuous monitoring of industrial processes, improving safety and operational efficiency . The company's revenue in 2022 reached \$13.4 billion, with significant contributions from tower leasing and indoor distributed antenna systems, reflecting the commercial viability of its extensive network .
