

How many optical ports and how many electrical ports does the switch have

Switches can have a mix of electrical (RJ45) and optical (SFP/SFP+/QSFP) ports, with the total number varying by model and configuration.

Electrical Ports

Electrical ports, typically RJ45 interfaces, are used for copper Ethernet connections. They support speeds from 10M to 10G, depending on the switch model, and are commonly used for access-layer connections to desktops, IP phones, or PoE devices . The number of electrical ports on a switch can range from a few to dozens; for example, a 48-port switch may have 24-48 electrical ports, depending on whether some ports are reserved for optical uplinks or combo configurations .

Optical Ports

Optical ports require SFP, SFP+, SFP28, or QSFP modules to connect fiber optic cables. These ports support higher speeds, typically 1G, 10G, 25G, 40G, or 100G, and longer transmission distances, up to 100 km with single-mode fiber . Some switches have dedicated optical ports, while others use combo ports that can function as either electrical or optical depending on the installed module . The number of optical ports varies widely; a typical enterprise switch may have 4-12 SFP/SFP+ ports, while data center switches can have up to 48 or more high-speed optical ports .

Hybrid and Modular Configurations

Many modern switches support hybrid configurations, allowing a combination of electrical and optical ports. For example, a switch may have four 10GE optical-electrical hybrid ports and four 10GE SFP+ optical ports, with the total port count reaching 48 when CSFP modules are installed, effectively doubling the number of logical ports . Port numbering follows a slot/subcard/sequence convention, which helps identify each physical and logical port in stacked or modular switches .
