Labor and installation typically account for 60-80% of total project costs, with materials contributing 20-30% .

Project Scale and Terrain

Costs vary based on project size, terrain, and population density. Urban areas are generally more expensive due to pavement restoration and regulatory requirements, while rural areas may benefit from simpler trenching conditions . For large-scale deployments, costs are often calculated per mile, with estimates of \$60,000 to \$80,000 per mile or \$1,000 to \$1,250 per residential household passed .
