- o Configure the Switch: Set the port mode to fiber if required, and configure network parameters such as VLANs, IP addresses, or link aggregation as needed .
- o Test the Link: Verify connectivity and signal quality. Clean connectors if necessary to prevent signal loss .

Additional Considerations

- o Bandwidth Matching: Ensure the SFP module supports the desired network speed (1G, 10G, or higher) .
- o Topology: For multiple switches, consider star or daisy chain topologies to optimize performance .
