

How to connect a fiber optic cable with two inputs and one output

Fiber optic couplers are optical devices that connect three or more fiber ends, dividing one input between two or more outputs, or combining two or more inputs into one output. The device allows the transmission of light waves through multiple paths. It can also be a device for coupling (launching) light. Proper connection of fiber optic cables is essential to harness these benefits fully, as even minor errors can lead to significant performance issues like signal loss. Once connected, two digital optical inputs can be used alternately, with no loss in sound quality.

In cases where the distance between switches exceeds the total cable length, you can use the LC-LC coupler to connect two fiber optic cables together. For example, insert the connector

We terminate fiber optic cable two ways - with connectors that can mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear or with splices which create a permanent

Shown below is a simple 1X2 splitter with one input and two outputs. Basically, in one direction it splits the signal into 2 parts to couple to two fibers.
