



How to connect a fiber optic router and set-top box

To connect a fiber optic router and set-top box, link the fiber to the ONT, connect the ONT to the router via Ethernet, then connect the set-top box to the router using Ethernet or Wi-Fi, and configure the devices for internet and TV services.

Step 1: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable to the ONT

Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home. Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT (Optical Network Terminal), which converts the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals your devices can use. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2-5 minutes .

Step 2: Connect the ONT to the Router

Use a high-speed Ethernet cable (CAT6 or better) to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the WAN port on your fiber-ready router. This allows the router to receive internet data from the ONT. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 3: Configure the Router

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1). Enter your ISP account information if required, and configure settings such as VLAN ID or Quality of Service (QoS) for optimal performance. Ensure the router firmware is up to date to maximize speed and stability .

Step 4: Connect the Set-Top Box

Depending on your set-top box type:

- o Ethernet connection: Plug an Ethernet cable from the router's LAN port to the set-top box. This provides a stable connection for IPTV or streaming services.
- o Wi-Fi connection: Connect the set-top box to the router's Wi-Fi network. Ensure the router is centrally located for strong signal coverage .

Step 5: Test and Optimize

- o Verify that the set-top box receives a network connection and can stream content.
- o Test internet speed on other devices to ensure the router is delivering full fiber performance.
- o For large homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi or additional access points to maintain coverage for the set-top box



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and other devices .
