

How to connect the secondary distribution box wires

Article Overview

A secondary distribution box (subpanel) is connected using two hot wires, one neutral, and one ground wire, with careful separation of neutral and ground bus bars for safety.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. **Safety First** Before starting, turn off the main breaker and ensure no power is flowing to the circuits. Use insulated tools and wear protective gear to prevent electric shock. 2. **Mount the Subpanel** Secure the subpanel to a wall or structure, ensuring it is accessible and meets clearance requirements (at least 3 feet in front and 30 inches wide) . 3. **Run Feeder Wires from Main Panel** Use a four-conductor cable or conduit:

- o Two hot wires (usually black and red) for 240V supply
- o One neutral wire (white)
- o One ground wire (green or bare copper) Pull these wires from the main panel to the subpanel location . 4.

Connect Wires in the Main Panel

- o Attach the two hot wires to a double-pole breaker in the main panel
- o Connect the neutral wire to the main neutral bus bar
- o Connect the ground wire to the main ground bus bar . 5. **Connect Wires in the Subpanel**

- o Hot wires: Connect to the main lugs or main breaker in the subpanel
- o Neutral wire: Connect to the isolated neutral bus bar (do not bond to the panel enclosure)
- o Ground wire: Connect to the ground bus bar, which is bonded to the panel enclosure . 6. **Branch Circuit Connections**

- o Connect individual circuit wires to the appropriate single-pole breakers
- o Neutral wires from branch circuits go to the neutral bus bar
- o Ground wires go to the ground bus bar . 7. **Verify Proper Grounding** Ensure the subpanel's ground bus is connected to a local earth electrode or ground rod. This provides a safe path for fault currents and stabilizes voltage . 8. **Final Steps**

- o Secure the subpanel cover
- o Turn on the main breaker feeding the subpanel
- o Test each circuit for proper operation
- o Schedule an inspection if required by local electrical codes .

Key Safety Notes

- o Never connect the neutral and ground together in a subpanel; they must remain separate
- o Use the correct wire gauge and breaker ratings based on load calculations
- o Follow local electrical codes and NEC guidelines for installation . By following these steps, your secondary
