

How to fix the cable tray hangers

Key Steps to Fix Cable Tray Hangers

For lighter cables like data or phone lines, a single central rod or wall-mounted brackets may suffice . 2. Determine Support Spacing Spacing between hangers is critical. Standard practice is 1.5 to 2 meters, but heavier cables require closer spacing to prevent sagging. Always allow a safety margin of at least 25% above the current cable weight . 3. Mounting Options

- o Ceiling-Mounted Rods: Threaded rods suspend the tray from the ceiling, keeping cables elevated and accessible for maintenance .

- o Wall-Mounted Brackets: Ideal for limited floor space or when ceiling mounting is not possible. Brackets secure the tray against the wall and prevent shifting .

- o Floor-Mounted Bases: Used in industrial areas where ceiling or wall mounting is impractical . 4. Secure the Hangers Use mounting clamps, nuts, and bolts to firmly attach hangers to rods or brackets. Ensure that wall bolts are strong enough to handle the load without pulling out of concrete . Adjustable hangers can help fine-tune tray alignment. 5. Check Alignment and Stability After installation, verify that the tray is level, straight, and free from wobbling. For T-joints or intersections, ensure that hangers are positioned to support all connected sections . 6. Additional Accessories

- o Tray Hangers: Provide extra support for heavy cables .

- o Cable Tie Mounts: Keep cables organized and prevent slipping .

- o Cover Clips: Secure tray covers to prevent rattling or dust ingress .

- o Avoid mixing incompatible parts from different brands.

- o Use corrosion-resistant materials like hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel in wet areas .

- o Regularly inspect hangers for signs of bending or loosening, especially in high-load areas. By following these steps, your cable tray system will remain safe, organized, and durable, minimizing the risk of sagging or cable damage.
