

How to install arc-shaped cable tray supports

Article Overview

Arc-shaped cable tray supports are installed by using appropriately spaced support brackets or hangers, ensuring the tray follows the curve while maintaining structural integrity and proper load distribution.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, determine the radius of the arc and the type of cable tray (ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom). - o **Attach the Arc-Shaped Tray:** Place the tray onto the supports, aligning it with the curve. Use tray clips or fasteners to secure the tray to the support brackets. For ladder trays, clips can be installed inside or outside the tray depending on space and accessibility.
- o **Adjust and Level:** Fine-tune the height and alignment of each support to ensure the tray follows the arc smoothly. Check that the tray is level along the curve and that there is no undue stress on joints or bends.
- o **Verify Load and Clearance:** Confirm that the tray can safely carry the intended cable load without exceeding the maximum support spacing or load rating. Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables to prevent damage.
- o **Bonding and Grounding:** Ensure all tray sections are properly bonded and grounded according to electrical codes, especially for metallic trays.

Final Checks

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- o Inspect all fasteners and supports for tightness and stability.
- o Verify that the arc maintains the correct radius and that cables can be installed without sharp bends.
- o Confirm compliance with relevant standards and manufacturer guidelines . By following these steps, arc-shaped cable tray supports can be installed safely and effectively, providing reliable cable management while accommodating curved routing paths.
