

How to replace the wiring in the distribution box

Preparation and Safety

Wiring Connections

- o **Connect Input and Output Wires:** Attach the main power input to the designated terminals. Connect branch circuits to their respective breakers, following color coding standards: line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground .
- o **Secure Connections:** Tighten screws or clamps to ensure firm contact. Loose connections can cause overheating or electrical faults .
- o **Neat Wiring Layout:** Route wires neatly inside the enclosure, using cable ties to organize them and leaving space for ventilation .



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- o Label Circuits: Clearly mark each circuit for easy identification during future maintenance or troubleshooting .

Testing and Final Checks

- o Visual Inspection: Check all connections, ensure no exposed conductors, and verify proper placement of breakers and wires .
- o Electrical Testing: Use a multimeter or insulation resistance tester to confirm correct wiring and absence of short circuits before powering on .
- o Power On and Monitor: Switch on the main supply and observe the system for any abnormal behavior, such as tripping breakers or unusual heat .
