

How to set up grounding for a distribution box

Proper grounding of a distribution box requires correctly sized ground wires, secure connections to mounting plates and central grounding points, and a total system resistance below 0.1 Ohm.

Grounding Wire Requirements

- o In the US, use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire for the distribution box; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard .
- o For connections between the mounting plate and spindle plate, use a 16 mm² wire (or 6 AWG / 13.29 mm² in the US) to ensure low resistance regardless of tool cable length or number of spindles .

Connection Points

- o Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate.
- o Connect a second ground wire from the mounting plate to the factory central grounding point .
- o For stainless steel enclosures, ensure material compatibility between connectors and the box to prevent electrochemical corrosion, and use flexible copper braided tape for bonding moving parts like doors .

Resistance Requirements

- o The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm .
- o When multiple grounding paths exist (e.g., tool cable and ground wire), calculate the parallel resistance to ensure the total remains below the threshold .
- o For general distribution systems, a maximum of 25 Ohms is recommended for the grounding electrode system, verified with proper testing .

Installation Best Practices

- o Remove coatings or oxide layers at contact surfaces to reduce resistance .
- o Use anti-loosening washers to maintain secure connections over time .
- o Avoid aluminum conductors for buried runs; use copper for durability and conductivity .
- o In outdoor or high-humidity environments, apply conductive paste to prevent oxidation and maintain low resistance .
- o Ensure grounding paths are continuous and properly bonded to prevent step and touch potential hazards .
