Proper installation of a construction distribution box involves careful site selection, secure mounting, correct wiring, grounding, and thorough testing to ensure safety and reliable operation.

Site Selection

Choose a dry, well-ventilated, and accessible location close to the main power supply to minimize power loss and facilitate maintenance. Avoid areas with high humidity, corrosive substances, flammable materials, or explosive hazards. For outdoor installations, ensure the box has adequate IP/NEMA ratings for waterproofing and dust protection . The recommended installation height is typically 1.5 to 1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation and inspection .

Mounting and Fixing

- o Wall-mounted boxes: Use expansion bolts, dovetail bolts, or split bolts depending on wall type. Ensure the box is level and flush with the wall .
- o Cabinet/panel installations: Place cabinets on foundation steel according to construction drawings. Adjust perpendicularity and levelness using sizing blocks if necessary, and secure with bolts .
- o Ensure the box is firmly fixed to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or collision .

Wiring and Circuit Connection

- o Power Off: Confirm the power supply is completely disconnected before starting.
- o Wire Preparation: Strip insulation to expose the conductor, leaving an appropriate length for connection .
- o Circuit Breakers: Install breakers according to load requirements. Each circuit should have its own protection device, such as fuses or surge protectors .
- o Termination: Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground following color coding standards. Secure wires with screws or wire strippers .
- o Wiring Layout: Route wires neatly, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation. Avoid tangling or contact with sharp edges .
- o Labeling: Mark each circuit clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting .

Grounding and Safety

- o Connect the metal box, electrical board, and internal appliances to a reliable grounding system.
- o Use copper wires to connect the PE row to grounding bolts, adding spring washers to prevent loosening .
- o Install a leakage protector for additional safety .
- o Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed to prevent exposure to moisture or dust .

Testing and Inspection

- o Perform visual checks for loose connections or damaged components .
- o Conduct an insulation resistance test using a qualified tester to verify proper insulation between wiring and the box .
- o Check control circuits and busbar connections, ensuring correct phase alignment and secure fastening .

Special Considerations

- o In flammable or explosive environments, use explosion-proof distribution boxes and follow specific material and grade requirements .
- o For high-voltage installations, perform tests approved by the local power supply authority and adjust relays and interlocks as required . Following these steps ensures a safe, reliable, and code-compliant installation of a construction distribution box, minimizing risks of electrical faults, fire hazards, and maintenance difficulties.
