All interval wiring should conform to the relevant International Best Practices. For general site work additional precautions are necessary. Earth Leads Earth leads must be colored yellow and green, and yellow should be of stranded copper or copper alloy with a cross section of at least 6 sq.mm. The maximum size need not e. All extension cables / cords should have a current inspection tag affixed and should be checked for damage prior to use. Extension cables / cords in one office should not be used to supply power to another office, building or adjacent offices. Cables / Cords may not run through doors, windows or ceilings unless for the purposes of temporary constru.

For the purposes of this Article, it is considered that relevant modifications and major repairs are those which impact at least 50% of the capacity installed at the Electrical Installation or that impact whole
