

Article Overview

Standard network cabinets have a 19-inch internal mounting width, variable height in rack units (U), and depths ranging from 600mm to 1200mm.

Width

The internal width of most network cabinets is standardized at 19 inches (482.6 mm), following the EIA-310 standard. This width includes the mounting rails where equipment ears attach, ensuring compatibility with servers, switches, patch panels, and other rack-mountable devices .

Height

Cabinet height is measured in rack units (U), where 1U = 1.75 inches (44.45 mm). Common cabinet heights include 24U, 42U, 45U, and 48U, with 42U being the most widely used in data centers . The total internal height is calculated by multiplying the number of U by 1.75 inches. For example, a 42U cabinet provides 73.5 inches (1866 mm) of vertical space for equipment.

Depth

Internal depth varies depending on the type of equipment and cable management needs. Typical depths range from 600mm to 1200mm, with 600-800mm suitable for network switches and shallow devices, and 1000-1200mm required for deep servers or high-density installations to allow proper airflow and PDU placement .

Mounting Rails and Hole Spacing

The vertical mounting rails inside the cabinet follow the EIA-310 standard, with holes spaced to accommodate standard rack units. This ensures that any 19-inch rack-mountable device can be securely installed. Rails may be adjustable in depth to fit different equipment sizes and allow for cable management .
