The modular design allows for flexible installation, including straight runs, horizontal and vertical bends, tees, and reducers .

## Connection Methods

### o Splice Plates

- o Splice plates are used to join two straight sections or fittings securely.
- o They are bolted to the side rails, ensuring alignment and load transfer across the joint .
- o Properly installed splice plates maintain the tray's structural integrity and prevent sagging.

### o Fittings

- o Horizontal fittings allow the tray to change direction on the same plane (e.g., 30°, 45°, 90° bends).
- o Vertical fittings (risers) enable elevation changes between floors or equipment levels.
- o Tees and crosses create branches for routing cables to different areas .
- o Fittings are connected to straight sections using bolts or integrated splice systems.

### o Supports and Mounting

- o Ladder trays are supported using trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or ceiling mounts to maintain proper alignment and load distribution .
- o Supports are typically installed at intervals defined by the tray's load class, which specifies the maximum span for a given cable weight .
- o J-bolt kits or drilled mounting points can secure trays to equipment racks or cabinets .

### o Covers and Hold-Down Clamps

- o Covers protect cables from dust, debris, or accidental contact.
- o Hold-down clamps secure covers to the tray base, especially in industrial or high-vibration environments .

## Best Practices

- o Ensure alignment of side rails before bolting splice plates.

- o Maintain consistent rung spacing to support cable weight evenly.
- o Verify load ratings and support spacing according to manufacturer specifications.
