

Location of the electrical distribution box in the medical technology building

Article Overview

Electrical distribution boxes in medical technology buildings are typically located in secure, accessible utility rooms or dedicated electrical closets, designed to comply with medical safety standards.

Typical Placement

In medical facilities, the main electrical distribution board (MDB) or sub-distribution boards are usually installed in:

- o Dedicated electrical rooms or service areas that are clearly marked and restricted to authorized personnel.
- o Near the building's main utility entry point, often on the ground floor or basement, to facilitate connection to the public electrical supply and backup systems.
- o Away from patient care areas to minimize exposure to electrical hazards while maintaining accessibility for maintenance and emergency response.

Safety and Regulatory Considerations

Medical locations have enhanced electrical safety requirements due to the critical nature of patient care and the use of sensitive medical equipment :

- o Section 710 of BS 7671 and IEC 60364-7-710 specify requirements for medical locations, including the classification of safety services and essential electrical systems.
- o Redundant power paths are often implemented, including dual public supply feeds, UPS systems, and backup generators, to ensure continuous operation of life-support and critical medical equipment .
- o Automatic Transfer Switches (ATS) are used to switch between normal and safety power supplies within milliseconds to prevent interruption to critical loads .
- o Electrical distribution boxes must be clearly labeled, with circuits for essential medical equipment separated from non-essential loads to prevent accidental disconnection.

Practical Guidance

- o If you need to locate the distribution box in a specific building, consult the building's electrical schematics or facility management team, as the exact location is determined by the building design and local regulations.
- o Only qualified personnel should access these panels due to the risk of electric shock and the critical nature of the connected equipment .
- o In some cases, medical IT systems or isolated power supply systems (IPS) may have separate distribution panels for sensitive areas like operating rooms or intensive care units . In summary, while the exact location of
