The mold is reinforced to maintain its shape during casting. Molten bronze, heated to over 1,000°C (around 2,000°F), is carefully poured into the mold. Sprues, runners, gates, and risers are used to introduce the bronze and allow gases to escape, preventing air bubbles and defects .

Cleaning and Finishing

Once cooled, the plaque is removed from the mold in a process called knocking out. The surface is sandblasted to remove residual sand, and excess casting components like sprues and gates are trimmed. Edges are sanded, and raised letters or borders are polished. Backgrounds can be darkened to enhance contrast, and optional coatings or lacquer can be applied for weather resistance .

Mounting the Plaque

For installation on a distribution box, mounting holes through the face are recommended. Decorative rosettes can cover screw heads, and plaques can be rolled to fit curved surfaces if needed. Ensure the plaque is securely fastened to withstand outdoor conditions .
