

Methods for Drilling and Fixing Cable Trays

Step 5: Fixing Cable Trays

Place the cable tray sections on the supports and connect them using approved fittings. Ensure joints are tight and aligned. Smooth any cut edges and apply rust-proofing if necessary. Expansion joints should be installed where required to accommodate thermal expansion .

For metal trays, install bonding jumpers across tray sections to maintain electrical continuity and safety. Ensure proper grounding according to electrical standards .
