Step 4: Wiring Connections

- o Turn off the main power supply and verify with a voltage tester. Place a warning sign to prevent accidental energizing ().
- o Introduce wires into the box and connect them according to the wiring diagram.
- o Ensure correct polarity, proper insulation, and secure grounding.
- o Use the correct wire gauge and breaker size for each circuit.
- o Include protection devices such as MCBs, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit ().

Step 5: Testing and Acceptance

After wiring, perform a visual inspection and use a multimeter to check connections. Test the leakage protector and conduct a power-on test to ensure all circuits function correctly without abnormal sounds, voltage drops, or power fluctuations ().
