

Mobile communication fiber optic cables were cut

What Happens When a Fiber Cable is Cut

A fiber cut is a complete or partial severance of a fiber optic cable, which interrupts or degrades data transmission across the network. Fiber optic cables are the backbone of modern communication, transmitting data as light pulses through thin strands of glass or plastic. When a cable is cut, it can temporarily disable mobile and internet services in the affected area, as seen in past incidents like the Verizon outage in multiple U.S. cities .

Common Causes

Fiber cuts can occur due to:

- o Construction and excavation: Accidental digging or drilling can sever buried cables.
- o Natural disasters: Earthquakes, floods, or severe weather can damage cables.
- o Animal activity: Rodents may chew on underground cables.
- o Equipment failure: Rare defects in the cable or connectors can lead to breaks . Intentional acts, such as sabotage or maritime accidents, have also caused undersea cable cuts, affecting regional or international connectivity .

Repair Process

Repairing a cut fiber optic cable requires specialized tools and careful procedures:

- o Locate the break: Use visual inspection or an OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) to pinpoint the exact fault .
- o Prepare the cable: Cut out damaged sections and strip the protective jacket and Kevlar fibers without damaging the core .
- o Clean and cleave the fiber: Ensure the fiber ends are smooth and free of contaminants for low-loss splicing .
- o Splice the fiber: Join the ends using mechanical or fusion splicing to restore a stable, low-loss connection .
- o Test the connection: Measure signal loss to confirm the repair is successful . Repairs can take hours to days depending on the location, accessibility, and whether the cable is owned by a third-party vendor .

Impact on Services

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A cut fiber optic cable can cause widespread service disruptions, including loss of mobile coverage, internet outages, and degraded network performance. The severity depends on the network design and redundancy; some areas may experience complete outages while others may have partial service .
