Belarus imports optical fibres and cables from several countries, with Germany exporting approximately \$230,000 worth in 2024.

Overview of Optical Cable Imports

Belarus imports optical fibres and cables as part of its broader telecommunications infrastructure development. In 2022, Belarus imported \$607,000 worth of optical fibres and cables, ranking it as the 168th largest importer globally. The main suppliers were China (\$466k), Croatia (\$57k), Israel (\$18k), Turkey (\$14.7k), and India (\$12.5k), with Croatia and Turkey showing the fastest growth in exports to Belarus between 2021 and 2022 . Germany specifically exported \$229,800 worth of optical fibres, bundles, and cables to Belarus in 2024, according to UN COMTRADE data . These imports are part of Belarus's strategy to maintain and expand its optical network infrastructure.

Market Context

The Belarusian optical fibre cables market has experienced fluctuations over recent years. While domestic production has seen modest declines, overall consumption has grown, reflecting increasing demand for high-speed internet and telecommunications services . Russia remains the largest destination for Belarusian optical cable exports, but Belarus also imports significant volumes from multiple countries to meet domestic needs .

- o Market Trends: Growth in imports from Croatia and Turkey indicates diversification of supply sources.
- o Economic Impact: Optical cables are a small but strategic component of Belarus's total imports, supporting telecommunications infrastructure and digital connectivity . In summary, Belarus relies on a mix of international suppliers for optical cables, with Germany being a notable exporter, and the market is influenced by both domestic demand and regional trade dynamics.
