Material Selection

Cable trays can be fabricated from steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements. Aluminum offers excellent corrosion resistance due to its natural oxide layer, while stainless steel (AISI 316L) is ideal for highly corrosive or coastal environments like Palau. Fiberglass trays provide high resistance-to-weight ratios and are suitable for chemical or marine exposure .

Types of Cable Trays

- o Ladder Tray: Ideal for heavy power cables, allows ventilation and heat dissipation.
- o Ventilated Trough: Protects cables while allowing airflow, suitable for instrumentation and control cables.
- o Solid-Bottom Tray: Provides maximum protection against dust and moisture.
- o Wire Mesh Tray: Lightweight, flexible, and suitable for light cabling or retrofit installations .

Installation Methodology

- o Inspection and Verification: All trays and accessories must be checked against approved material submittals. Damaged or non-conforming items should be reported and replaced .
- o Support and Alignment: Trays are mounted on supports, hangers, or brackets as per approved shop drawings. Spacing of supports typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load .
- o Orientation: Standard installation has rungs horizontal, but edge-wise orientation (vertical rungs) is permissible if manufacturer guidelines allow, minimizing dust accumulation in tropical environments .
- o Securing and Fastening: Use approved bolts, clamps, and covers. Ensure proper grounding and bonding where required. Avoid bending or damaging coatings during installation .
- o Cable Entry and Exit: Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray terminations. Use bends, tees, and reducers to route cables efficiently .
- o Inspection and Testing: After installation, QA/QC inspection ensures compliance with project specifications, coating integrity, and alignment .

Best Practices

- o Plan tray routes early to minimize conflicts with other services.
- o Use ventilated trays in areas with high heat or moisture.
- o Maintain clear access for future cable additions.
