To configure a panel router for fiber optic internet, connect the fiber line to the ONT, link the ONT to the router's WAN port, and adjust the router's network and security settings via its admin panel.

Physical Connection Setup

- o **Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** The fiber optic line from your ISP terminates at the ONT, which converts optical signals into electrical signals compatible with your router . Place the ONT near the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss .
- o **Connect the Fiber Cable:** Carefully insert the fiber optic cable into the ONT's input port, ensuring the connector is clean and properly seated .
- o **Link ONT to Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet output to the router's WAN port . Power on both devices and wait for the indicator lights to stabilize.

- o **Access the Admin Panel:** Open a web browser on a device connected to the router and enter the router's default IP address (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1), . Log in using the default credentials (often "admin" for both username and password).
- o **WAN/Internet Settings:** Navigate to the WAN or Internet settings section. Select the connection type provided by your ISP, typically PPPoE, DHCP, or Static IP . Enter the ISP credentials if required.
- o **LAN Settings:** Configure the router's IP address and subnet mask to ensure it does not conflict with other devices on your network .
- o **Wi-Fi Configuration:** Set your network name (SSID) and a strong, unique password. Choose WPA3 or WPA2 encryption for security .
- o **Advanced Settings:** Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP, gaming, or video conferencing to prioritize traffic . Update the router firmware to the latest version for stability and security.

Final Steps

- o **Save and Reboot:** Apply all changes and restart the router to ensure settings take effect .
- o **Test Connectivity:** Verify that devices can access the internet and that speeds match your fiber plan.
- o **Maintenance:** Regularly update firmware and change passwords to maintain security. Following these steps ensures your panel router is properly configured for fiber optic access, providing high-speed, reliable, and secure internet connectivity.
